This a building complex with a museum on the first floor and a library on second and third floor.

The architect wanted an attractive appearance and that the floors should fit well into the environment. A special stone mix was designed to achieve this.

The floors should emit low noise and be comfortable to walk on. They must be easy to clean.

Barrikade Stone Carpet was used in all exhibition areas and library areas including reception, reading rooms and activity rooms.

Barrikade Stone Carpet was installed on 5000 m² of in situ concrete.
